Programs & Services

SEASPAR offers a wide variety of therapeutic recreation programs and services. Our staff and volunteers are trained in behavior management, physical adaptations, and social issues to ensure a positive experience for all participants. Programs and events are located in community settings throughout our member entities and beyond, with transportation provided to many of these locations from pickup/drop-off points within our service areas.

Weekly Programs & Special Events

We conduct an assortment of weekly programs and special events, many of which can be enjoyed year-round. Others change with each season, ensuring diversity for a healthy leisure lifestyle.

Day Camps

We offer a variety of camp programs that enrich the summer and other school breaks for children and teens. Campers enjoy field trips and traditional camp activities that help provide structure during their time off school.

Special Olympics

We provide training in more than a dozen Special Olympics sports for athletes to enjoy the spirit of competition. Athletes train under the guidance of experienced coaches and have the opportunity to participate in local and state Special Olympics events and other competitions.

Adapted Sports

Our adapted sports program ensures that physical, visual, or hearing impairments don't stop participants from enjoying the challenges and rewards of participating in team and individual sports. We are a Paralympics Club and have joined other agencies to host clinics and competitions for youth and adults with physical disabilities.

Wonders Multi-Sensory Room

Our award-winning Wonders Multi-Sensory Room in Lisle contains interactive equipment that pleases the senses in a variety of soothing ways. The room primarily benefits individuals with autism/autism spectrum disorders, sensory processing disorders, ADHD, and dementia.

EAGLES Adult Day Program

EAGLES is a year-round life skills enrichment program designed to assist adults with disabilities, ages 18 through 50, transition to life in the community. This program emphasizes leisure independence, community awareness, and social interaction with peers.

Inclusion Services

We assist each of our member entities in responding to their residents' needs by providing technical assistance, workshops, and direct staff support when residents with disabilities participate in their programs. The inclusive recreational environment provides individuals with disabilities more choices for their leisure.

Cooperative Programs

We partner with many organizations to offer cooperative recreation programs. These agencies may include schools, nursing homes, disability-specific organizations, group homes, and other agencies. By sharing resources with these organizations, we are able to provide services to a wider range of individuals with disabilities.
