### Summer 2024 Registration

Program Runs: June 10<sup>th</sup> – August 14<sup>th</sup>

To be considered for the program, the following application is required by **April 30**<sup>th</sup>.

The Literacy for Life program is currently enrolling high school students and adults with intellectual or developmental disabilities, such as Down syndrome or autism. In a group setting, participants will focus on improving their reading and writing abilities to support their transition from school to the workforce.

Areas of focus will include:

- Health literacy
- Financial literacy
- Fluency in the use of technology
- Community-based literacy activities, such as ordering from menus and completing job applications
- Reading and writing for pleasure

#### **Application for Summer Program**

Any evaluation services provided will be billed separately at current SLI rates. Sessions can be billed to insurance pending speech and language diagnosis and a copy of a recent speech and language evaluation if the provider accepts services from the Speech-Language Institute.

Cost: \$25 each session.

Parents/caregivers are expected to remain on site for the duration of each session so that they can observe participation and progress.

To be considered for the program, the following application is required by April 30<sup>th</sup>. Applications will continue to be accepted after that deadline, however, you will be placed on the waitlist if the group is already at capacity.
